SUPPORT BILL 5483

It's a good start and would impose a <u>dock moratorium</u> along the lower river until suitable regulations can be enacted. Immediate actions are necessary because <u>the legislative</u> session ends May 8 and decisions are being made right now about what will get considered. That's why it's crucial that you contact the legislative leaders <u>today</u>.

The Bill: (Approved by the Joint Environmental Committee by a vote of 22-6 on March 18,2002)

AN ACT CONCERNING PERMITS FOR MARINE STRUCTURES IN THE GATEWAY REGION OF THE CONNECTICUT RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Environmental Protection, in accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, shall adopt regulations for the issuing of permits for marine structures in the Gateway Region of the Connecticut River. Such regulations shall include, but not be limited to, a consideration of the environmental impacts of such structure and the preservation of the natural habitat of such area including the **historical nature** of such area or the **scenic quality** of such area. **No permit** for a marine structure in the Gateway Region of the Connecticut River shall be issued **until such regulations are adopted**.
